



NNS Kicks Off Annual Holiday Food Drive

Newport News Shipbuilding's annual Holiday Food Drive to benefit the Virginia Peninsula Foodbank (VPF) kicked off today and will run through Friday, Dec. 16. The "Shipbuilders Caring and Sharing" campaign will collect canned food items to assist the foodbank in meeting the needs of local communities this holiday season. VPF serves the areas of Newport News, Hampton, Williamsburg, Matthews, Gloucester, York, James City, Surry and Poquoson.

Food drive facilitators have placed labeled collection boxes inside designated NNS buildings, warehouses and at piers, docks and trailers (first floor locations only). Coordinator and box locations are available on Yardnet.

The Foodbank accepts all non-perishable food donations in non-glass containers. Canned items that are most needed include: meat, fish and protein (tuna, ham or chicken, beef stew, chili, peanut butter and canned/dried beans); fruits and vegetables (100 percent fruit juice, instant potatoes and fruit preserves); complete meals (pasta and sauce, boxed meals and hearty vegetable soups); and grains (cereal and rice 2# bag/box or under).

For every dollar donated, the Peninsula Foodbank will be able to provide four meals. Career Pathways Participates in Grand Opening Event for New Local Learning Center

Newport News Public Schools recently held a grand opening and ribbon-cutting ceremony for a new technology learning center at Crittenden Middle School. The center offers students hands-on opportunities with STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) programs including augmented reality, 3-D printing and robotics using state-of-the-art technologies.

SMALLab Augmented Reality Learning, now offered at the center, is one of only 60 in the world and the only of its kind in Virginia and blends human computer interaction with science education.

Girls with Engineering Minds in Shipbuilding (GEMS), sponsored by Vice President of Engineering and Design **Jennifer Boykin**, participated in the event. NNS representatives showed off new drafting tables and talked to attendees about the GEMS program and how it can lead to careers in STEM fields.

Congressman Bobby Scott, representing Virginia's Third Congressional District, and Dr. Ashby Kilgore, Superintendent, Newport News Public Schools, were present during the event.

"The suggestions and ideas contributed by the members of GEMS during Northrop Grumman Foundation's Fab School Lab makeover contest were instrumental in developing the final design of Crittenden's new Technology Learning Center," said Kilgore. "This new interactive learning center was developed by students for students; each feature engages and promotes learning. Thanks to the support of Newport News Shipbuilding mentors, our students are learning more about STEM and the exciting careers offered in these fields."

Electric Boat Christens Virginia-Class Submarine *Colorado* (SSN 788)

Ship’s Sponsor Annie Mabus, daughter of Secretary of the Navy Ray Mabus, christened *Colorado* (SSN 788) in a ceremony at Electric Boat (EB) in Groton, Connecticut on Saturday, Dec. 3. *Colorado* is the 15th Virginia-class submarine to be christened in a partnership between Newport News Shipbuilding and EB.

“The submarine *Colorado* will forever embody magnificence, adventure and freedom,” said Newport News Shipbuilding President **Matt Mulherin**. “The qualities are especially fitting, as they also reflect Annie Mabus’s independent spirit and strong sense of equality that she will impart on this boat.”

Construction on SSN 788 began March 2, 2011, and the submarine is expected to be delivered to the Navy in late 2017.


