



The End of an Era: USS *Enterprise*

Navy sailors on board USS *Enterprise* (CVN 65) walked off “Big E” for the last time, during the Decommissioning Ceremony at Newport News Shipbuilding on Friday, Feb. 3, marking the end of an era.

More than 400 guests including shipbuilders, Navy personnel and family witnessed the historic event held in the carrier’s hangar bay. For many shipbuilders who helped build *Enterprise*, it was an emotional and bittersweet sendoff as they said goodbye to a legend.

Designer **Luther Peacock** remembered traveling across the James River Bridge to start his shipyard career in 1958 and, like other shipbuilders at the ceremony, had mixed emotions.

As he watched Commanding Officer Captain Todd Beltz give final commands, Peacock remembered standing in the same hangar bay more than 50 years ago.

“I was standing right here, helping put this thing together,” he said. “I never thought I’d get to be part of something this great. It’s probably the best ship we’ve ever built. These guys are leaving behind something that is a legacy around the world.”

Construction Supervisor **Jennifer Guthinger** supported *Enterprise* during an Extended Dry-Docking Selected Restricted Availability in 2010 and was part of the team leading the inactivation at NNS.

“I thought it was a very special ceremony,” said Guthinger. “A lot of people put their hearts and souls into this ship. There are no words to describe her. You have to be part of it—in the shipyards building them or on the water sailing them.”

L.D. Joyner, production planner and scheduler, started his career in the shipyard’s Mold Loft in 1957. He and several...

GEMS Find Inspiration in *Hidden Figures*

On Feb. 2, Newport News Shipbuilding's Career Pathways program, Girls with Engineering Minds in Shipbuilding (GEMS), treated 86 girls from Crittenden Middle, Heritage High and Booker T. Washington Middle Schools to a special screening of the Oscar-nominated film *Hidden Figures*.

Before the film started, Vice President of Engineering and Design **Jennifer Boykin** provided the students with some background information.

"You're going to see the true story, a Hampton Roads story, about a number of women who had to break through a lot of challenges to set the stage for what we have today," said Boykin. "We owe a lot of gratitude to the people who are in this movie."

The outing held special meaning for Nuclear Inspector **Melissa Vaughan** (O39), the granddaughter of Dorothy Vaughan—the NASA mathematician portrayed by Octavia Spencer in the movie. Vaughan, who has worked at the shipyard for 16 years, said that a lot of what her career has become today is owed to her grandmother and the struggles she went through.



"She taught us how to do complex math," said Vaughan. "She was always very adamant about education and performing to your fullest. We are so proud and honored to have the matriarch of our family, to have her story portrayed in theaters means so much."

She hopes her grandmother will also be an inspiration to GEMS students. "I want these girls to know that no matter what obstacles come their way, you maintain your character and your integrity. That's what my grandmother always taught me."

GEMS is an afterschool mentorship program for middle school girls who are interested in science, technology, engineering and math. NNS sponsors the program at Crittenden and Booker T. Washington Middle Schools.

"It doesn't matter who you are or where you come from, it's what you bring to the table," said Crittenden Principal Felicia Barnett. "When you bring a spirit of excellence to everything you do, opportunities are endless."

Huntington Ingalls Industries was awarded a \$25.5 million modification to an existing advance planning contract in support of advance fabrication of *Enterprise* (CVN 80) on Jan. 31. The initial structural fabrication and shop work on the carrier will be performed at Newport News Shipbuilding.

"This award authorizes us to begin fabrication of structural components, sub-components, sub-units and pre-assemblies in our manufacturing shops to support the 2018 construction of *Enterprise*," said **Mike Shawcross**, vice president of CVN 79 and CVN 80 Construction. "This is an important step in getting this next *Ford*-class ship off to a great start, as it allows us to continue implementation of lessons learned, and the initial steel work will allow us to utilize our aircraft carrier steel production line in an efficient manner."

...other shipbuilders fabricated molds for the steel used in the original construction of *Enterprise*. Fifty-nine years later, he said that he felt honored to be part of "Big E's" legacy.

"Sure, there will be another *Enterprise*," he said. "But there will never be another CVN 65. It was just an awesome ship. You feel proud to be involved in something that made history and protected the United States."

While there may never be another CVN 65, "Big E" will live on through the next generation *Enterprise* (CVN 80).

"We've taken some of her steel and will use it in the keel of our nation's newest *Enterprise* (CVN 80)," said NNS President

Matt Mulherin. "And just like this ship, CVN 80 will hold a special place in the hearts of her shipbuilders. We are continuing the magic, the majesty and the legend that is and will always be *USS Enterprise*."
